ORDER

The United States has submitted an application pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3122 and 3123, requesting that the Court issue an Order authorizing the installation and use of pen registers and trap and trace devices ("pen-trap devices") on the substitute servers and other infrastructure established by the Government pursuant to the Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause signed by this Court in the matter of United States v. Peter Yuryevich Levashov (the "TRO").

The Court finds that an attorney for the government has submitted the application and has certified that the information likely to be obtained by such installation and use is relevant to an ongoing criminal investigation being conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in connection with possible violations of 18 U.S.C. §§ 371, 1030, 1037, 1343, and 2511.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3123, that the Federal Bureau of Investigation may install and use pen-trap devices to record, decode, and/or capture dialing, routing, addressing, and signaling information for each communication sent by computers infected with the Kelihos malware that communicate with the substitute servers and other infrastructure established by the government by the following attributes of communication: the exchange of peer lists, job messages and job requests, including the date, time, and duration of the communication.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3123(c)(1), that the use and installation of the foregoing is authorized for sixty days from the date of this Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall provide the Department of Justice with certified copies of this application and Order, and shall provide copies of this Order to the Federal Bureau of Investigation upon request;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the application and this Order are sealed until otherwise ordered by the Court, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3123(d)(1).
